For this week, the Studio's chefs will offer *Asian Ramen Bowl*; *Mushroom & Burrata Ravioli*; and *Goey Chocolate Brownie*, as the three dishes they're available to teach culinary enthusiasts.

Launching Community Hours at The Foodhall Cookery Studio is the brand's way of further encouraging and promoting customers' love for food.
